

<p>Personal Social and Emotional Development:</p> <p>During this topic we will be learning how to stay safe in the sun and on the beach. We will learn how to keep ourselves and others safe and learn the importance of wearing sun cream and knowing what the flags on the beach mean.</p>	<p>Communication and Language:</p> <p>Throughout this topic we will be learning new vocabulary and how to apply new words. We will be learning names of sea animals and developing our talking through explaining our ideas linked to beach safety.</p>	<p>Physical Development:</p> <p>We will be exploring the sand pit in our nursery grounds to dig, sculpt and build using our gross motor movements. We will learn to transport water across different size containers and build up the strength in our arms to pour.</p> <p>We will continue to develop our pencil control and how to identify our own names.</p>	<p>Literacy</p> <p>In our writing we will be expressing our learning of sea animals and sun safety. We will learn how to draw our favourite animals and learn to write our names on our work.</p> <p>In reading, we will be exploring topic related books to connect our learning and retelling stories through the use of small world toys.</p>

<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>During this topic we will use our observational skills to learn how to apply colour for purpose. We will be exploring how sand can create detail and texture on our paintings.</p> <p>We will be exploring tissue paper and learning how to 'layer' materials to create different effects.</p>		<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Throughout this topic children will be learning names and facts about animals that live in the sea. They will share conversations relating to their experiences on the beach. Children will also learn the importance of staying safe in the sun.</p>
