



**Mathematics**

The focus of mathematics teaching in Year 2 is to ensure that pupils develop confidence and mental fluency with whole numbers, counting and place value. This will involve working with numerals, words and the four operations, including using practical resources.

**PSHCE**

Develop confidence and responsibility.  
Share opinions on things that matter to them and explain views their feelings in a positive way.

**English**

Write poems, reports, instructions and narratives about personal experiences and fictional events.

Read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and discuss our understanding of them.

**History**

Look at the lives of significant people.  
Learn about the importance of great explorers.

**Music**

Explore pulse, rhythm and pitch.  
Improvise and compose using instruments.

**Computing**

Record and enter data into a computer  
Use data to make observations and predictions.

**P.E.**

Outdoor games  
Athletics

**Science**

Work scientifically in investigations.  
Observe closely, using simple equipment  
Perform simple tests.

**Geography**

Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns.  
Compare hot and cold areas of the world.

**D&T / Art**

Develop artwork in the style of Constable.  
Create artwork using mixed media.

**Religious Education**

Special people in Christianity and Hinduism.  
Christian and Hindu stories.
