## UNIVERSAL INFANT FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Next Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019, is a National School Census Day. This is when the Department for Education (DfE) collects information about each school to help them set future school budgets. One of the figures we have to report is the number of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children who have a meal on this day. This data is then used to set our meal funding for the rest of the year.

There are just two dates in the year where this information is collected, so if your child chooses to have a meal on another day, we fund this from our general school budget.

**Our solution to this is to ask every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 to try the hot meal on Census Day (Thursday). Then your child will be fully funded to have hot meals during the year thus saving the school any additional costs.** Thank you for your support.

## Application for a Primary School Place (even if already in Minpins)

Parents of all children whose date of birth is between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 need to apply for a school place for their child **even if their child is already attending Minpins**. Applications should be made online using [www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions), the Cornwall Council website or by printing the paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101). If you would like assistance in completing your application please speak to Mrs Gooding. **The deadline for applications is 15 January 2019.**
