

## Swimming at Bude Primary School 2017-18

Our school recognises the importance of swimming as an invaluable life skill. Many of our children enjoy spending time at Bude's beaches and unique sea pool, they enjoy water-based activities on the river and canal and many frequently visit the nearby Tamar Lake. Within opportunities we provide at school also include visits to our beaches, canal and lakes to carry out a range of outdoor adventurous activities. All of our year 3, 4, 5 and 6 children have an 8 week block of swimming – they focus on improving their stroke technique as well as personal survival skills. Our staff are very proud of the progress that our children make during their swimming sessions and Mr Dart has attended training courses this year to further enhance the knowledge and skills in the teaching of swimming.
