Membership:

Excluding the Headteacher, the Committee shall comprise of at least 3 Governors who are not disqualified by having an interest requiring them to withdraw.

Quorum:

The quorum shall be 3 governors

Chairman:

The Committee shall appoint a Chair annually at its first meeting held in the Autumn Term of each year

Meetings:

The committee shall meet at least once per term or otherwise as required

Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the School Governance (Procedures) (England) Regulations 2003, as amended by the Regulations 2007, the personnel procedures adopted by the Governing Body from time to time and the Whole School Pay Policy.

Terms of reference:

- To support the Governing Body in setting the strategic direction of the school by challenging school self-evaluation and ensuring accountability.
- To consider and advise the governing body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements relating to the National Curriculum
- With the assistance of the staff, to provide information about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced
- To review the school's policy and provision for collective worship and Religious Education and make recommendations to the Governing Body
- To review the policy and provision for sex education and make recommendations to the Governing Body
- To receive reports from the governor responsible for special educational needs and to ensure that the provision for pupils with special needs are made
- To review the content of the school website (to ensure statutory compliance) and promotional materials annually for approval of the Governing Body.
- To review the School Improvement Plan annually or otherwise as required for approval of the Governing Body
- To contribute to the School Improvement Plan

- To oversee arrangements for individual governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision, e.g. SEN, English & Maths.
- To make arrangements for the Governing Body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the LA and for reports to be received by the Governing Body
- To receive a report annually or otherwise as required from the Headteacher on such areas as performance management, staff development, safeguarding
- To review information that is required to be published about results and standards
- To review standards and progress across all Key Stages.
- To monitor and evaluate the Curriculum within the school and to monitor all relevant data.
- To maintain and continue to improve links with local Pre-School and Nursery provisions and with local Secondary Schools.
- To monitor and review the provision of extended school activities.
- To review, with guidance from the Headteacher/Assistant Headteachers all Curriculum Policies on a regular basis.
- To ensure that attendance and admissions records/registers are properly maintained.
- To ensure staff awareness and implementation of policies relating to pupils: e.g. safeguarding & child protection, substance abuse, bullying & harassment.
- To oversee arrangements for educational visits, including the appointment of a named co-ordinator
- To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance and Staffing decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the Governing Body
