

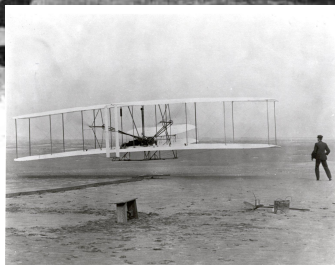
Create your own instrument that can make sound- Can you get creative and make it out of any recyclables you have at home. You can present it to the class explaining how you made it and how it works.
