




Curriculum Yearly Plan 2020-2021













EYFS

In EYFS we plan shorter topics in the form of open-ended questions. This gives us the flexibility to take the children's interests and questions into account when we ask them what they want to find out. For example, with "What's in the sky?" children may want to learn about space, rockets, stars, fireworks, birds, helicopters, the weather.....If a class are really enjoying a topic and getting lots of new learning from it, we can stay on a topic for longer. Alternatively, we can move onto the next one quicker if we need to.
