

Pupil Premium Financial Statement 2016-17

Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011. The pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise attainment and accelerate progress of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities and to close the gaps between them and their peers.

Funding for Financial Year 2016-2017

£1,320 for each child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years:

£1,900 for each pupil identified in the spring school census as having left local-authority care because of 1 of the following:

- adoption
- a special guardianship order
- a child arrangements order
- a residence order

Service Pupil Premium

Service Pupil Premium (SPP) was introduced in April 2011 in recognition of the specific challenges children from service families face and as part of the commitment to delivering the armed forces covenant. It is designed to assist schools in providing the additional support that these children may need and is currently funded at £300 per service child who meets the eligibility criteria.

Pupils attract the SPP if they meet the following criteria:

- one of their parents is serving in the regular armed forces
- they have been registered as a 'service child' in the school census at any point since 2011
- one of their parents died whilst serving in the armed forces and the pupil receives a pension under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme or the War Pensions Scheme

The Purpose of the Service Pupil Premium

Eligible schools receive the SPP so that they can offer mainly pastoral support during challenging times and to help mitigate the negative impact on service children of family mobility or parental deployment.

Schools should not combine SPP with the main Pupil Premium funding and the spending of each premium should be accounted for separately.
