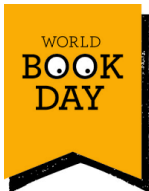
## HEAD OF SCHOOL UPDATE

A reminder that we finish for the Spring half term next Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> February at 3.15pm.

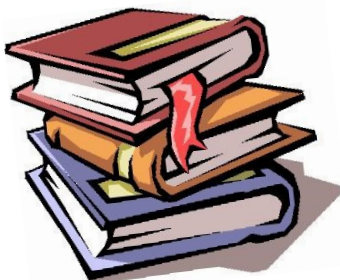

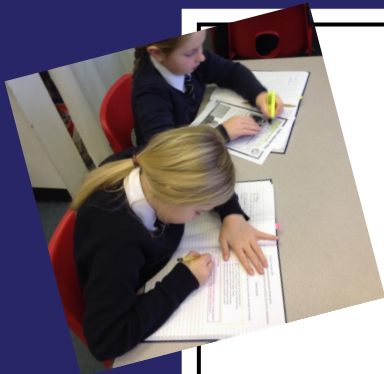

Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 parents are invited into class from 9.15am until 10.30am.



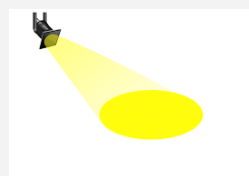

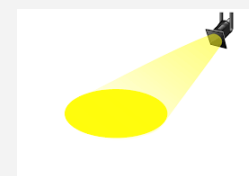
