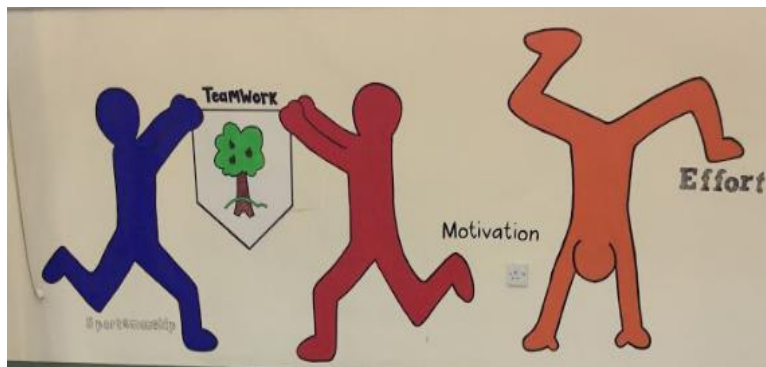
### Games award
