Year 6 trip to Fleet Air Arm Museum

As part of our topic on World War II we have arranged an exciting trip to Fleet Air Arm museum. The trip has been planned to develop the children's understanding about what life was like for a child at this time. In addition, they will be introduced to new themes relating to the 'Home Front' in preparation for our work in term 4. The children will have the opportunity to take part in two workshops, activities and tour the museum.

We will be going to Fleet Air Arm Museum on **Thursday 13th February**. We will be leaving at 9am and will return at approx. 3.30pm, travelling with Real Coach Hire. The cost of the trip will be **£16.00** (free to children entitled to Free School Meals because you receive qualifying benefits). This contribution is voluntary but it should be noted that if insufficient contributions are received, it may not be possible for the trip to go ahead. This will be the main trip for this academic year.

In keeping with the theme, we would like your child to wear an evacuee outfit on this day. By wearing an outfit it will help them get into the spirit of the event and the workshops we will be doing. This outfit will be required again, later in term 4, when we will be holding a VE day celebration. Attached are some images that may support you in organising an outfit; this does not have to be complicated or expensive but perhaps items added to current uniform. They must bring a packed lunch in a small bag with 2 drinks (no fizzy please). They may bring up to a maximum of £3 spending money in a named envelope/wallet. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch this can be booked in advance on Wisepay. If you have already booked a hot school meal for the day of the trip a school packed lunch will be provided instead.

Please give your consent and payment for this trip on your Wisepay account by **Friday 30th January**.
