

The child or someone in their household develop symptoms of persistent cough and/or high temperature, and/or loss of smell or taste.

NHS 'Test and Trace' have identified the child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Coronavirus.

Do not send your child to school. Book a test for the individual who is developing symptoms. All household members must self-isolate until the outcome is known. **If this is likely to take several days and your child is well in themselves we WILL provide work to complete at home.**

The child self-isolate for 14 days. **The school WILL provide work to complete at home for any children who are not displaying symptoms.**

**Positive test for the child.** Please notify the school by email. School will contact Public Health Team who will advise on Risks to school community.

**Positive test for someone in the household.** Please notify the school by email.

**Negative test for someone in the household or child.** Please notify the school by email.

Isolate for 10 days from date of onset of symptoms. Return to school if well enough even if the cough and loss of taste/smell persists. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone. **The school will not provide work until your child is well enough.**

The household self-isolate for 14 days. **The school WILL provide work to complete at home for any siblings who are not displaying symptoms.**

The household self-isolate for 14 days. **The school WILL provide work to complete at home for any children who are not displaying symptoms.**

The child returns to school when well enough.

*There is no automatic expectation that other children in the class bubble will isolate. Public Health will advise school if this is the case.*

If the child develops symptoms please inform the school and book a test.
