NEW ADVENTURE GAME AT ST NICHOLAS PARK, WARWICK

Octavian Droobers Orienteering Club and Warwick District Council are pleased to announce the introduction of two orienteering trails around St Nicholas Park. A grant from the council has been instrumental in the installation of these permanent courses.

A map complete with instructions can be downloaded free via www.octavian-droobers.org website, click on newcomers and permanent orienteering courses and in addition copies of the map are available free from the tea shop and the leisure centre. It is a great way to explore the park using the paths and crossing the grassy areas on either the short 1.9km course or the longer 3.6km course.

The courses start and finish on a wall near the front of the tea shop (facing the crazy golf) and the aim is to proceed from control point to control point in order noting down the code letter on to the map - a bit like a treasure hunt.
