

The Reception Round-up!

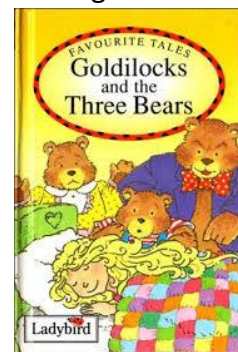
Some of the lovely things we have been learning this week:

2 fingers underneath

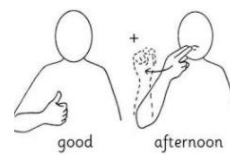


1 thumb at the top
