Topic:

We will be learning what plants need to grow and the different parts of a plant. We will have an art lesson with Mrs Constable to draw a flower, a PE lesson with Mrs Gray and some social time in 'breakout rooms' with Mrs Fawbert!

Maths:

Next week we will be teaching All About the Number 10. Watching **Numberblocks Series 2 'Ten'**. We will learn the formation of 10. We will find different ways to represent 10. We will also practice our adding, subtracting and word problems. How to make 10p and introduce the 10p coin! Please rehearse all the number bonds to 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9 and 10! We'd love the children to gain a quick mental recall of the pairs that make each number.
