### **Polite Reminders for Parents**

**Parent Pay:** Please can all parents sign up and regularly check Parent Pay.

**Emails to Parent:** Weekly communication like the newsletter is sent to all parents via email. If you are having trouble receiving your emails please check with the office that we have the correct address for you and it is also worth checking your 'spam' or 'other' folder to see if it has gone in there.

**Returning to school 48hours after sickness:** Should your child have had sickness or diarrhoea please can you ensure to keep them at home for 48 hours after the illness has finished. During this period your child is still contagious and by keeping them at home we can reduce the risk of child to child contamination.

**Please stay out of the classroom:** Please can we reiterate the importance of dropping your child off at the external door. We encourage our pupils to be independent and a prompt start to the morning routines. This can be delayed by parents remaining in the classroom after dropping off. Should you wish to speak to a teacher, please let the office know and they will arrange for the teacher to give you a call after school.

**No mobile phones in school:** Please leave your phone at home or in the car when visiting the school. Or if that is not possible, please hand your phone into the office for safe keeping. Many thanks.

**No sweets in school:** The children celebrate their birthdays whilst in school in a number of ways depending on which class they are in. Bringing in cakes/sweets is not permitted as it often causes upset for children and other parents. We thank you for your understanding with this.
