All schools have to complete a Census three times a year. This Census collects information about the school including the amount of school dinners which are served. The Government then provides the school with funding dependant on the numbers provided on those specific days. So, we ask that all pupils please have a school meal on 'Census Day' which is Thursday 16th May.

Every meal counts on these days!

Is your child entitled to Pupil Premium/FSM?

Many of our families are eligible but are not actually claiming the funding that could be coming into school to support their child. A form will be sent home today for ALL parents to complete should you wish to. We would ask that unless you are 100% sure you do not qualify please complete this form anyway and return it to the school office on Tuesday. The form will take 2 minutes to complete and your child could be missing out on valuable Government Funding. Parents can alternatively apply online via www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolmeals.
