10 things you need to know for the end of term – holidays and starting back in September!

1. Please clear any outstanding debts for school dinners, breakfast club etc. by MONDAY 23rd JULY.
2. Year 3 beach day on Monday 23rd July.
3. Last day of school on Tuesday. Year 6 Leavers Assembly at The Falcon Hotel.
4. Purchasing school uniform can take place during the holidays. Any orders placed before 20th August will be delivered on the INSET days, 4th & 5th Sept.
5. We have a new website. This is an ongoing project so won't be perfect – YET! However, please visit www.budeprimaryacademy.org from now on!
6. You may or may not be aware, since joining the Aspire Academy Trust we are trialling a number of new admin systems that we will potentially then pioneer out to the right of the schools within Aspire. One of the new systems is Arbor which has replaced our old data system called SIMS. From September we will be texting you directly from your child's online record and therefore messages will come to you via text rather than via Schoolcomms.
7. All Aspire schools use an online payment system called Parent Pay. Parent Pay actually own Schoolcomms and so we are working on Parent Pay being accessible through the Schoolcomms app. However, if this is not possible parents will need to pay for trips, meal etc. via Parent Pay. More information on this will follow.
8. Introducing Parent Pay will mean children's meals will revert to being chosen in the classroom. The cost of meals will stay the same. Again, more information from Parent Pay will be sent home at the beginning of term.
9. The new term starts again on Thursday 6th Sept. The Infant classes will have new names in Sept – classes in both school may look a bit different too!
10. We welcome Mrs Stickney to Crackington in September alongside Miss Putnam.
