## 1. Minutes of the last meeting – order as below:

# 2. Adult Quiz – 18<sup>th</sup> May

- Tickets sold via PM Inventory was 100, big success 100% sale
- Big thank you to Tatiane, Amie, Sally and Steve Yately
- Pizzas too many but then people did not turn up.
  - Action: reduce pizza order to 2 slices per person plus 5 garlic breads for next year.
- In regard to numbers of attendees, we were expecting 43 staff and 49 parents (total: 92) but I counted on Friday that we had 41 staff and 39 parents (total: 80), so really same trend as last year but more money raised
- Revised date for next year. It has been suggested that the quiz night is moved to March next year as May is a very busy period with SATs. Further discussion suggested maybe moving the event to October or November.
  - Action: Review date for next academic year. (committee)
- Quiz master Steve Yately, happy to host event again next year.
  - Action: check date is ok with Steve
- Raised an amazing £545.41 which is £106 up on LY
- Committee suggested raising the cost of ticket next year to £9 which was met with agreement.
- The event ran over a little, so it has been proposed that the event start time is moved forward to 7.15pm start.

### 3. Royal Wedding – Mufti day

- The Royal wedding mufti day was a success with many children in fancy dress and lots wearing red, blue or white to celebrate.
- The committee has suggested a FOMP mufti account that allows parents to make a mufti day donation via ParentMail. This enables parents/carers to make a one-off donation to cover all FOMP mufti days and events for the year. The minimum amount if £5.00 as this is the minimum online payment with ParentMail. This would be an option, so parents/carers could still send their children in with money on the day. There were mixed opinions about the idea so the committee will consider the suggestion and how to proceed with rolling it out if it is decided to trial the idea.
- The event raised £ 367.84

# 4. Water Bottles for Sport Days

- We had lots of new parents helping with labelling the bottles which was great to see.
- Helpers from each year group and FOMP helped to distribute bottles on the day of each sports morning, with Year 5 and 6 receiving theirs on return from their offsite sports event.
- Bottles returned raised so far £112.08
- The cost of label printing was significantly higher this year so next year the suggestion is to opt for a simpler sticker and design next year to reduce costs.
  - Action: to explore print options and cost.
- It was suggested that next year the bottles are handed out in class by the teachers on the same day for the whole school the week the sports mornings start. All attendees agreed with this suggestion, so this will be actioned for next year.

#### 5. Book Sale

- FOMP held a book sale in the playground after school Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. The amount raised was £58.66 (Last one took place in 2015 raised £65.20). Thank you to everyone who helped set up and sell.
- The location of the sale was discussed, and it was agreed that for future events in the
  playground that the stall is set up further up the playground as many parents/carers might
  not have noticed the stall due to existing the school via the main entrance.
- The sale successfully cleared a lot of old books making space for new donations ahead of the summer fair. There are still several boxes of books which need to be sorted.
  - Action: Myriam and Sally to sort through books and remove old and damaged items.

- We have reached the target of 60 house boards which have now been printed and will be erected this week. A fantastic £750 has been raised.

- Other raffle prizes we now have 15 prizes and are looking at potential prizes from Holiday Inn, Kew Gardens and Sutton United.

- PA Sound system will be run by Adam Bonner. He will bring his own system.
- List of external businesses / sponsors is a work in progress with leads still being followed up. Nicki Richards will be running the craft stalls with the Girl Guides and the Police will have a stall.

  - Action: freeze the pops, organise ice box for storing and recruit volunteers (committee)
- Fair floor plan needs to be finalised.
  - Action: Myriam and Sally
- Gazebos are needed for all stalls
  - Action: Need to count number required and send out request via ParentMail to borrow outstanding number required.
- Community Advantages are running the football skills in the centre of the field. Myriam has been chasing to finalise details.
  - Action: Jo Bolton to follow up with Naz at Community Advantages
- Gemma Bonner has kindly offered to run a dance activity in the centre of the field
  - o **Action**: Myriam to follow up
- Miss Groom to advise children's song
- We would like to decorate the beer tent with world flag bunting
  - Action: Ms Brant to see if school has any
