





Dear Parents

This week is Mental Health Awareness week and during the week we have had daily class assemblies on this subject and shared a poster with them, which is now displayed in each classroom. Also, that each class is writing their own class Well-being Charter.

Kingfisher class have been studying Ancient Greece and have designed and made their own Ancient Greek artefacts using clay.




