

Have a super weekend.

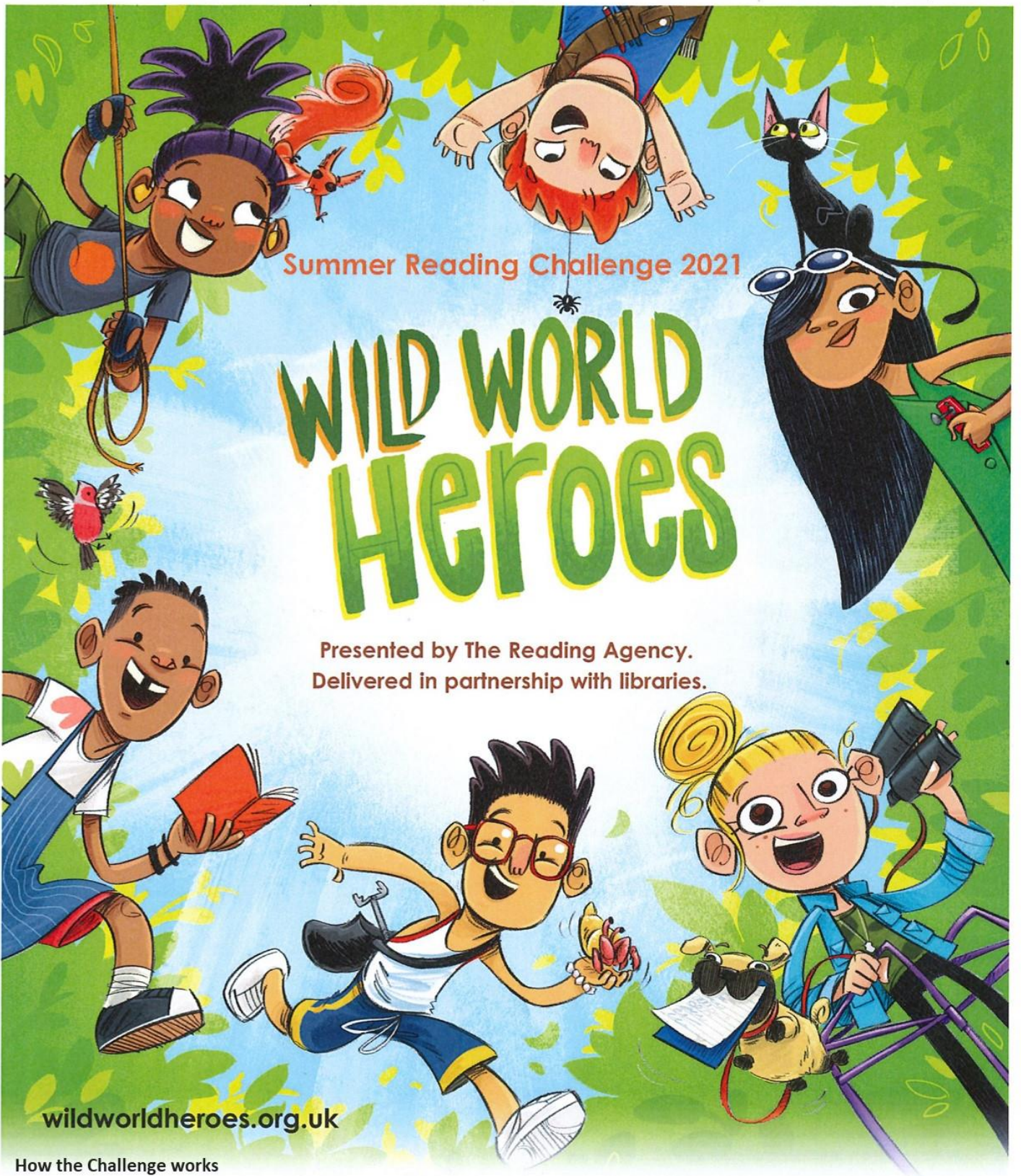
