

## English

Children will be exploring a range of texts linked with our theme and will include:

- Poetry- learn a poem by R L Stevenson off by heart and perform in a group. Write a poem based on a theme.
- Narrative- a fantasy story set in Ancient Egypt
- Non-Chronological report- about Rivers.
- Explanations- mummification.
- Reading and comprehension activities.
- Spell CEWs and words with common suffixes and prefixes.
- Use all punctuation taught this year.
- Understand grammatical terms taught this year.

## Science- Light

Children will learn to:

- recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light
- notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes
- recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object
- find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change
- use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

**PE** Children will take part in:

- Ball games including tennis, rounders and cricket.
- Athletics and orienteering activities.


## PSHE

## Art & Design

Children will:

Children will:

- Locate the World's continents, countries, oceans and seas using maps and atlas.
- Learn about the physical features of a river.
- Learn about the location and features of the longest rivers in the world and their impact on the people who use them.
