In Magpies class we will be exploring light and dark. We will be measuring our shadows and using light meters to measure brightness. We will be learning how to use data loggers.

Linking to our theme we will be studying the blackouts in World War 2 and how important it was to stop the light.

We will be creating observational poems about candles and light, that will include similes.

Our visit to Coldham Wind farm will enable us to understand how electricity is generated so that we have light.

We have been very fortunate to have the opportunity to learn about wildlife and nocturnal animals with the Wildlife Corridor Group who are environmental educationalists. They will be working with year 3 making seed bombs to disperse seeds next year. This will create a sustainable food source for birds in our school environment. It may be messy work, but it will be fun!
