1. Please notify the Treasurer of the SSSF (via the school) if you:
 - a) Want to cancel this declaration
 - b) Change your name or home address
 - c) No longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains to cover the amount that would be reclaimed on all Gift Aid donations.
2. Unless cancelled, this declaration will last indefinitely and cover all future donations.
3. Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax, currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25p for every £1 donated. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
4. The wording of the declaration reflects requirements of HMRC as revised in 2012, but any previous declarations remain valid.
