



Don't buy a new school bag this summer!

We need a lot less stuff to be coming into school every day! We are really tight for space and want to make sure that whilst everybody has everything they need we are minimising the space taken up by coats and bags.

This letter is inside your new school book bag. From September you need to use this bag to bring your things into school. Every child will be using one – we do not want children to bring rucksacks or holdalls.

In school you will be provided with everything you need for your learning day. In your book bag you should have:

- Your Home/School Diary and/or reading log/spelling book
- Your reading book
- Your homework (if you are taking it home or returning it to school)
- Your healthy snack (please see separate letter)
- A cap if you think the sun might come out

You do not need to bring stationary, notepads or toys. You should have a water bottle in school already, if you have lost it please bring in a new one with your name on.

Children who have a packed lunch will be asked to put their box and drink on the trolley outside the hall as they come into school. The trolley will then be stored in the hall ready for lunch time.

If you have PE or a sports club after school, please wear your school PE kit to school in the morning. (See separate letter)
