1. Give the book marks out of ten and give reasons for this score.
2. Write a note to your friend telling him or her about this book. Explain why you think he or she should read it.
3. Draw a picture of your favourite part of book. Write a short description of what happens.
4. Draw a picture of an important part of the story. Explain why you think this part is important.
5. Write down 3 new words you have learnt from this book and explain what they mean. Then try and use them in your own sentences.
6. Do you think the writer of this book uses words in an interesting way? Find and copy three examples, then explain why you chose these examples.

7. Draw a picture of your favourite character and write a description of them.

8. Summarise the story you have read under these headings:

- Opening
- Beginning
- Middle
- Ending

9. Copy out your favourite sentence from this book.
Why do you like this sentence?

10. Make up three questions you could ask someone about this book to test whether they have read it carefully.

11. Make up a word search or crossword based on the book.

12. Write about the main character in the story. Choose five words to describe his or her behaviour. Give an example for each one. e.g. *Sally is foolish when she goes into the old mill by herself.*
