## The School Bus

If you have not applied for a pass please collect a form from our school office as you may be entitled to one. **If you have previously applied for one, think you may not use the service often, or do not use the bus at all but are eligible we would please ask you to still apply for a pass.** The service relies on the number of children with passes and we are keen to ensure that we can keep the bus running as it is invaluable to some of our families.
