Our After School Club currently runs Monday (for 6th Form and Fitzeb), Tuesday (for KS2 and KS4) and Thursday (for KS1 and KS3) from 3.35pm until 5:15pm. Transport can be provided for children in Cambridgeshire, alternatively you can collect your child. The cost per day is £11.00.

Children will be provided with fruit and drinks, although parents/carers can send in something more substantial if they wish. Our staff are more than happy to support the children/young person with this.

During each session we offer free flow activities of their choice if they do not want to join the structured groups. Structured activities will change day-by-day and are offered on all days. Examples are cooking, topical arts and sports.

We promote choice, and we will not make a child join in an activity they do not want to.

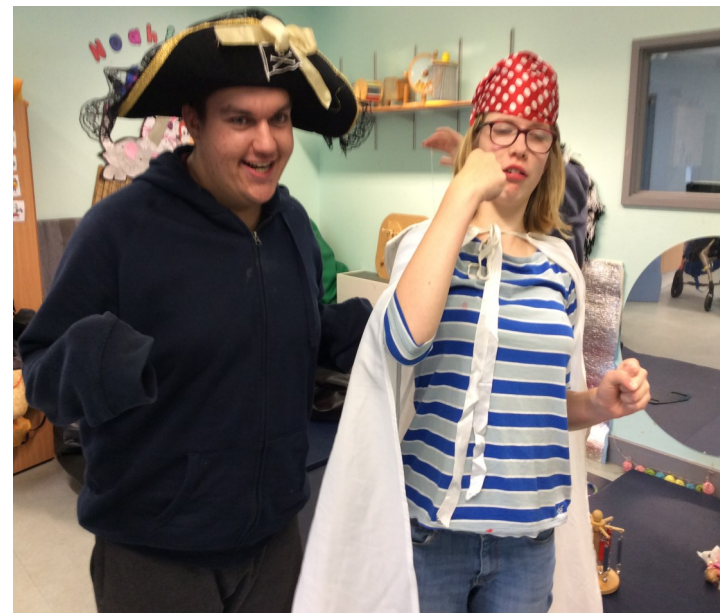


We aim to provide a wide range of activities from Arts and Crafts and messy play, to cooking, individual sensory work and outdoor play.
