REMINDER - HEALTH & SAFETY

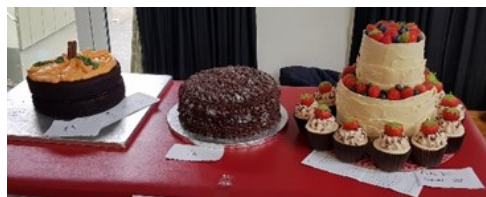
