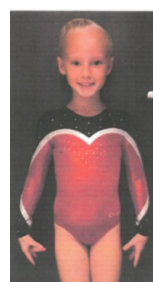
On Sunday 4th November Archie took place in The Men's Cornwall County six piece competition in Helston.
