Addition and Subtraction

To add/subtract a 3-digit number and ones/tens/hundreds.
To add/subtract numbers up to 3 digits with a formal written method.
To estimate and use the inverse operation to check the answer to a calculation.

Multiplication and Division

To calculate 2-digit multiplied by 1 digit numbers using a formal written method.
To calculate 2-digit numbers divided by 1 digit numbers using a formal written method.
To solve missing number problems including positive integer scaling problems and correspondence problems.
