Please be aware that we are not able to run school trips if we do not receive payment from parents. Our school budget is incredibly tight and we rely on contributions from parents to enable school trips to happen. The PTA

very kindly pay for coaches with money raised from fundraising and that helps reduce costs enormously but further contributions from parents are very much needed. If we do not collect sufficient funds, trips will not be able to go ahead. If your child is eligible for the pupil premium, you are entitled to a 50% discount.
