

Maths

We will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will link this to Dragons by problem solving how far the dragon can fly and how many dragon eggs have been born. We will explore how to solve problems. We will work hard to learn our multiplications and have weekly tests.

Science

We will be looking at states of matter and exploring what happens to a range of materials when in contact with a dragon's fire. We explore and investigate all living things, finding out about types of animals, including vertebrates and invertebrates, as well as habitats and feeding patterns.

Computing

We will use our geography field work to learn how to create our own databases, create a simple bar chart and use the internet to safely explore and build our map skills. We will also create our own Microsoft PowerPoints, learning how to copy and paste and add animations.

English

This topic we are linking our learning to the book called 'How to Train Your Dragon'. We will be using the event of a Dragon breaking into our school to write a letter of complaint. We will use our knowledge on states of matter to write a letter of persuasion to the Dragon as to why it cannot live in our school. We will use a sighting of the Dragon in the park to write a newspaper report. We will use our learning of the book studied and the rare threat of a dinosaur nearby to write an action narrative about how we trained our own dragon.
