In school we talk to the children regularly about their e-safety as part of the curriculum. For many parents, it is becoming more difficult to keep track on the appropriateness of the content their children are consuming, especially when the children will say, "But so-and-so plays it."

We are asking you to take a good look at your child's use of these marvellous devices they have at their fingertips; which if used safely are both fun and great for growing minds. However, we are concerned at some of the conversations we hear around school about our children having access to a range of content which potentially puts them in situations where unseen dangers could occur. Some commonly heard social media sites include these with a recommended minimum age of 13: Twitter, Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram, Pinterest, YouTube (13 with parental permission) and even Whatsapp which is rated as 16.

You will be receiving an e-safety booklet next week, which we encourage you to read through. But in the meantime, it would be well worth a visit to <https://www.internetmatters.org/> which is a fantastic resource aimed at keeping all children safe online. Mr Wyatt is our computing lead if you need any further guidance.
