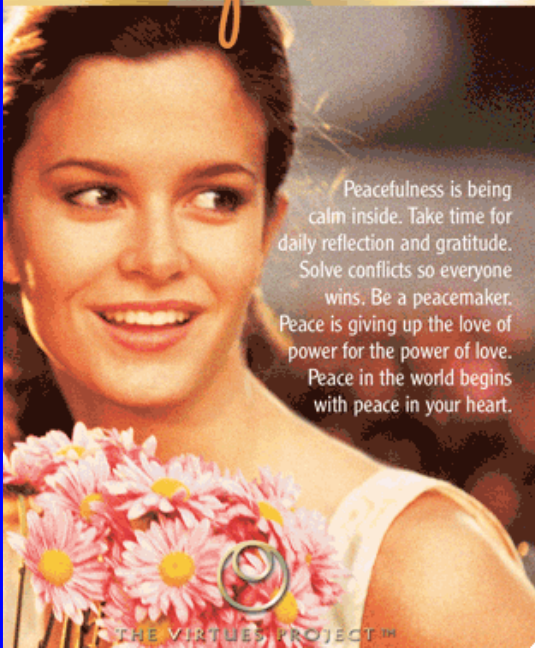




# Peacefulness

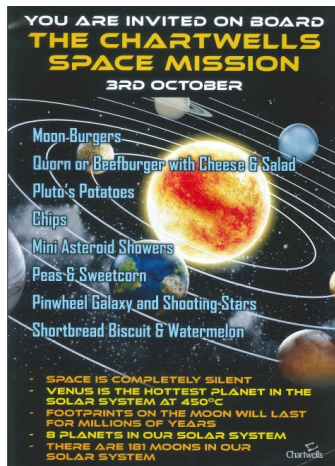
