This week's virtue is "Understanding".

Foundation stage

This week we are finding out about bees. We will be watching the bees in the bee hotel in the quad, reading stories and non-fiction books about bees to answer the children's questions.

In maths, we are looking at subtraction using pennies, symmetrical butterflies and bees during our forest school session as well as playing games are natural art.

Key Stage 1

Look out in book bags for two key letters. One is linked to the Year 2 sleepover (Thursday 27th June) and the breakfast banquet for all Year 1s the following morning. The second is for a KS1 Forest School Day held on Monday 24th June. The children will need to bring in an old white t-shirt as one of our activities is tie-dyeing. We still have some children without PE kits in school - please make sure your child has their kit in school that day so that they can take part. The Year 1s have completed their phonics screening test, which brings to a close all KS1 formal testing this year.

Key Stage 2

Year 3/4 are doing really well in their swimming lessons. We are finishing off assessments this week, carrying out another investigation about plants in science, and using leaves in our art lessons. We are looking forward to the surf days at the end of the week. We hope that the children's sunflowers are growing well despite the amount of rain we've had in the past couple of weeks - Let's hope we have some sunshine soon! Sunflowers don't need to be back in school until Monday 22nd July.

In year 5/6 we have begun our new science topic of the circulatory system learning about the importance of our hearts and their vital job in pumping blood around our body. We are continuing our geography topic looking at the effect of climate change on different people all over the world such as in Greenland, Australia and England. This week we are looking at ways we can help stop climate change. Please remember this Thursday and Friday year 5/6 have our forest schools day so the children need to come into school dressed in clothes they don't mind getting dirty and prepared for sunshine or rain!
