 - ✓ A loss of taste or smell.

If we are at all concerned we will ask you to collect your son / daughter and get them tested. This will keep all of us safe and complies with the guidance from Public Health England. PCR tests are very easily booked online and are coming back very swiftly.

Please do not risk others health by sending your son / daughter to school unwell.

- Please ensure you are able to collect your son / daughter if the need arises from illness or Isolation due to contact.
- Please continue to send students (if appropriate) to school with a mask to wear on the bus and in any busy areas such as corridors.
- Please practice hand washing and hygiene at home and (if appropriate) encourage your son / daughter to make this part of their daily routine.
- Please ensure your son / daughter is warmly dressed as we continue to keep classrooms well ventilated.
