RECEPTION TO YEAR 5 FLU IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME

Public Health England is extending its flu immunisation programme this year to include children from Reception to Year 5. It is taking place here at Manor Park on **Monday 19th November 2018** and forms accepting or declining the immunisation spray for your child or children will be sent home on Monday 1st October. **These forms must be completed indicating whether you want your child to be immunised or not and returned to the office by Friday 5th October 2018.**

Five reasons to vaccinate your child against flu:

1)The nasal spray helps protect against flu, has been given to millions of children worldwide and has an excellent safety record.

2)The nasal spray is painless and easy to have.

3) Flu can be really serious, especially for children with medical conditions like heart disease and diabetes.

4) If your child gets flu you may have to take time off work to look after them.

5) Protecting your child can stop flu spreading to other children and the family, especially babies and grandparents who may be at a higher risk from flu.

LATENESS

Arriving to school on time in the mornings is extremely important for a child as it ensures a good start to the children's learning and their day. It also enables them to see their friends or chat to other children in the playground before school and this enhances their confidence and social skills. Arriving late causes a child to feel embarrassed and unsettled and can also be very disruptive to the class who may have already started their learning or gone into the hall for assembly. If a child arrives after the register has closed at 9.30am this counts as an unauthorised absence on their attendance record. Most of our late arrivals are only a few minutes late in the mornings and we hope that the following suggestions may help if you have difficulty getting your child(ren) into school on time:

Ensure that your child has a good bedtime routine and a nutritious breakfast in the morning to set them up for the start of the day.

Allow enough time for your journey into school.

Always have a back-up plan if a problem arises-a family member or another parent who could bring your child to school in the morning.
