#### DIARRHOEA AND VOMITING ILLNESS

This time of year, Norovirus which can cause bouts of diarrhoea and vomiting is very common.

Public Health England recommend that children should be kept away from school for 48 hours after the last bout of vomiting or diarrhoea.

Occasionally, a child might have an isolated bout of an upset tummy which is not severe. In this instance, we

would rely on the judgement of our parents and carers as to whether this could be a virus or simply a one-off incident. If it is the latter, and the child has no other symptoms such as a fever, they may return to school 24 hours after the last bout of vomiting or diarrhoea.
