

School Absence Homework

Don't forget, your child must still be finding time to:

- **Read daily** - and check that they understand what they are reading with an adult. (Adult- please ask lots of comprehension questions to draw out the information such as; Why do you think ___ feels like that? What will happen next in the story? Tell me about the setting/characters.)
- **Practise spellings weekly** - All children have their weekly spelling lists so that they can continue to learn to spell the expected words.
- **Y2 - Y6: Times Tables Rock Stars** - remember to log in at least once per week.
