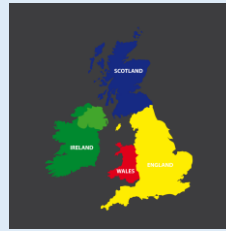
The children will take part in a daily Read Write Inc lessons where they will learn new sounds and read books at the appropriate level. The children will also take part in daily writing, grammar and spelling activities as part of talk for writing. The story that we will be looking at together will be an adventure story - Jack and the Beanstalk As part of our continuous provision, children will have the opportunity to read a selection of books linked to our topic as well as writing simple stories, sequence stories and writing invitations. The children will learn how to form all letters correctly through daily handwriting activities. We will enjoy listening to daily stories and poems linked to our topic of Where do I live?

Mathematics

The topics for this half term are place value to 50 and addition and subtraction. The children will be learning to: count and order objects to 50 and beyond, make and compare sets of objects and numbers, count forwards and backward, count in 2's and 10's, find one more and one less, and find numbers on a number square. They will use the < > signs (greater than / less than) to compare numbers. They will learn how to add and subtract numbers to 20 using a number line. We will use a range of different equipment to ensure children continue to learn through practical activities.

Science – Animals Including Humans

The children will be learning the names of different parts of the human body. They will be finding out about our five different senses and taking part in experiments to test their sense of taste, hearing, vision, smell and touch. The children will end the unit by making a sensory board.



Where do I live?

Computing

The children will be learning how to use a computer to play different maths and spelling games. The children will learn how to use a mouse and some of the functions on a keyboard.

PE

The children will be taking part in different fitness lessons and completing different fitness circuits. The children will continue to develop their throwing, catching, batting and racquet skills.

Creativity: Design Technology

The children will be learning about traditional food from different countries in the UK. The children will make welsh cakes, soda bread, scotch pancakes and scones. The children will learn about the different techniques used to make each thing and the compare the ingredients.

Music

The children will be exploring beat and pitch in music and learning linked to our science topic for example "Glad to be me! "

Geography - Countries of the UK

The children will start the unit by looking at their own local area and where it is on a map of the UK. The children will find out the names of the different countries in the UK and where they are situated on a map of the UK. The children will learn the name and the position of the capital city of each country . The children will find out about traditions linked to each country as well as listening to traditional stories including the stories of patron saints. The children learn to recognise the different flags.

RSE – Keeping Healthy

The children will be finding out about different relationships. They will follow the units about friendships, bullying, touch and body language. .

RE – Who is Jewish and how do they live?

The children will be finding out how people who are Jewish live. The children will find out about Jewish beliefs and value as well as looking at Jewish artefacts and different festivals. The children will find out about Jewish places of worship.
