



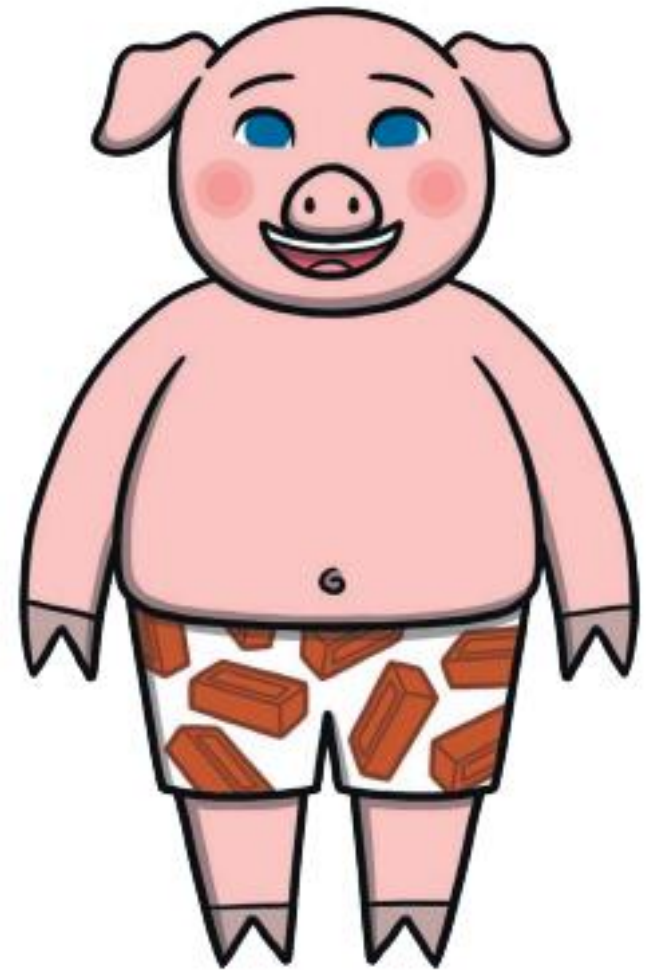
EYFS Homework menu Autumn Term (1st half) 2021

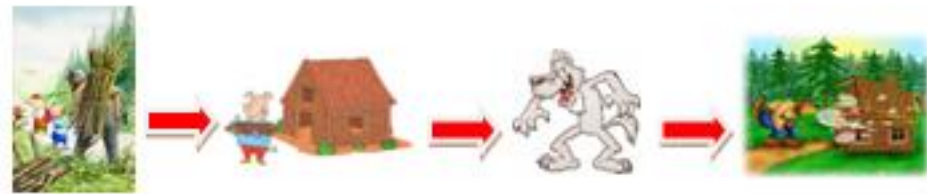
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell someone at home what our school diamond rules are. Draw a picture that shows how you can follow the diamond rules. • Tell someone about a friend you have made at school. Make a friendship card to give to your friend. • Talk about what makes you happy and sad at school. Draw a picture to show this.
Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to 3 new stories. Draw a picture of your favourite one. • Tell someone at home the name of 5 children in your class. • Learn one of our 'rhymes of the week' off by heart.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn how to skip (not rope skipping - hop, step, hop, step). • Practice your tripod grip with a pencil (nip, flip, grip). • Cut out the pictures of 3pigs below with scissors by yourself.
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the text map below to re-tell the story 'The Three Little Pigs.' • Practice saying, recognising and writing each new sound that we learn. • Write your first name by yourself.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count at least 5 toys. • Cut out the number cards below. put them in the right order and match the numbers to the pictures. • Complete a jigsaw puzzle with at least 10 pieces.
Understanding the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go on an 'autumn walk.' Collect things you find and make a picture from them. • To celebrate Harvest Festival, make an animal from fruit and vegetables. • Find out from an older relative what it was like when they started school. Draw a picture to show this.
Expressive Arts and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make a house for the Three Little Pigs. Use anything you like; junk, Lego, wood etc. • Spend time looking at your face in the mirror. Draw a picture of your face using the correct colours. • Make up a new story about the Three Little Pigs. Film yourself telling the story.
