

English

Both of our English texts this half term will be set in Egypt. The first is a tale of quest called Raiders of the Lost Tomb. Children will learn to retell this story before creating their own quest tale. We will then look at letter writing by writing letters to Howard Carter enquiring about his discoveries in Egyptian tombs. Our grammar focus will be on the use of noun phrases to enhance description and also the use of the past tense in different situations.

Mathematics

Our mathematics learning this half term will focus on developing a sound understanding of place value for numbers up to 1000. We will then progress to developing children's understanding of addition using a range of practical, visual and written methods. Children will develop both their mathematical reasoning and problem solving skills by applying this knowledge in a range of situations. Children will build upon their times tables knowledge by learning the 3 times table.

Science

In science, we will be looking at muscles, skeletons and teeth to learn about their importance in the human body. Children will also investigate the importance of a balanced diet and how these contributes to a healthy lifestyle.

Children will work scientifically in every lesson to develop key skills such as predicting, observing and drawing conclusions.

Land of the Pharaohs**Creativity: Art/DT**

Children will have an opportunity to create art using hieroglyphics and design a sarcophagus for an Egyptian pharaoh. We will also look at jewellery in Ancient Egypt and replicate this using everyday materials.

PE







During this unit, children will consider how they can face new situations – such as new procedures in school - and how these situations make them feel. We will also consider the importance of rules and personal responsibility both in and outside of school.





