Our usual celebration assembly will be held during the first week back after half term on Friday 1st November at 9am.

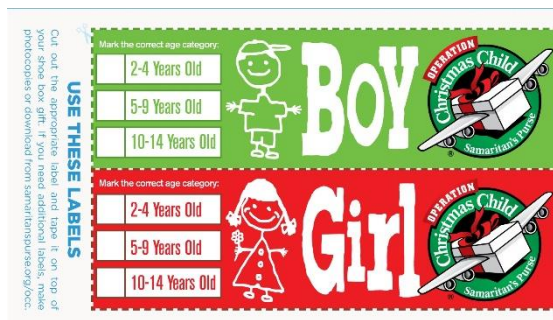
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD
