Dear Parent or Carer,

We have been made aware that we have a confirmed positive case of coronavirus (COVID-19) at Weston Mill Community Primary Academy.

We have followed the national guidance and, following a risk assessment with Public Health England (PHE) advisors, have identified that your child has been in close contact with the individual who has had a positive test result. In line with the national guidance, your child must stay at home and self-isolate until the end of the 15<sup>th</sup> July. The first day returning to school will be Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July.

Due to our bubble closing we will be moving learning online. This will mirror the provision that was put in place for the lockdown that happened in January.

There will be two live one hour lessons a day on Microsoft teams with all learning and resources uploaded to e-schools just as we did previously. These live lessons will be available for both Violet and Dandelion class including the Year 2's that are in Violet class.

Live lesson 1 will start at 10:30am and end at 11:30am. Live lesson 2 will start at 1:15pm and end at 2:15pm. There will then be work and activities uploaded to e-schools for your child to complete in between these live lessons. If you cannot attend at these times the live lessons will be recorded for you to access later on.
