Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have all had a calm and stress-free week and are looking forward to a relaxing weekend with some treats.

This week, I've definitely been noticing more and more Christmas adverts appearing on TV and social media and this has got us all thinking in school about the run up to the end of term and all the lovely Christmas joy we have got planned. However, this year we are still facing the problem of a high number of cases of COVID in Gloucestershire and the COVID restrictions we have had to put in place. This means that we are having to rethink how we do some of Christmas this year so we don't spoil anyone's Christmas with COVID and to keep everyone safe. So this year, for Christmas, we will be doing the following to ensure we all have a happy, safe Christmas:

- The Christmas disco has been rearranged for 1st April – no joke! This is to avoid any large gatherings as it states in our COVID risk assessment.
- We will still be performing a Christmas Play but we have made the decision to record it instead as we just cannot risk large gatherings in Church to watch it. We will video the children performing and singing and post the play online, via Google Classrooms, in the last week of term.
- Father Christmas will still make a guest appearance but probably in separate classes, rather than altogether
- Christmas dinner will still take place but this will more likely be in separate places. We will still make it fun for each class.
- We will close school an hour early on Friday 17th December. This will mean that 3.10pm will be 2.10pm for the Robins and 3.15pm will be 2.15pm for the Starlings and Owls. We will still remain open for those who have childcare arrangements for the normal end of day. However, after school club will close at 4.00pm on the last day of term.
- Also, due to the current restrictions in place, all clubs will be cancelled this term to avoid mixing of classes.

I'm also asking as a polite reminder not to park on the yellow zig-zag lines outside the school at drop-off and pick-up times. The zig-zags are there to keep our children safe so please do not use them as a car parking space. We have lots of on-street parking although I appreciate that the walk might be a bit longer than some would like. I will be approaching cars who park there and politely asking them to move on.

Recently, we've noticed that the area by the Trim-Trail is getting muddy and dangerous again. To help avoid any slipping accidents, we are going to send the Starlings out into the Playground by the lower gate, where they came out before. Please can parents congregate in the Playground to avoid muddying up the grass near the Trim-Trail and making it a dangerous place to stand.
