**World Book Day** – We all had a lovely day yesterday celebrating World Book Day and it was wonderful to see such a range of fantastic costumes. A big well done and thank you to the parents and children for making such an effort. World Book Day, of course, is not just about dressing-up, it is about celebrating books and promoting the importance of reading. To achieve this the school took part in a range of book related activities – making a book mark, designing some underpants and drawing a pet for the Gruffalo! We all had a great day!

**Science Workshop** – The children in Crenver Class attended a workshop at CSIA Nexus on Wednesday morning to further their learning about 'light'. The children investigated how the amount of light given out (lux) from a model lighthouse increased with the use of additional mirrors. The children used light sensors to log and assess the measurements to help reach an overall conclusion.

**British Science Week** – Last year Mr. Hunkin challenged the children to design and construct an accurate timer at home as a joint project with their parents. Each entry was tested and scrutinized with prizes given to the winners judged on overall presentation and accuracy. There was a good amount of thought given to each design and everyone involved had a really fun time.

This year Mr. Hunkin's challenge is to design a home-made 'egg drop-box'. The children must design and make a box and packaging to afford the maximum protection to the contents when dropped from a height of 2 metres. Letters will be sent home to the Year 3-6 children shortly.
