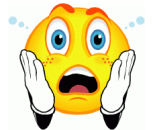

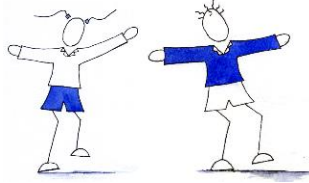
Don't forget we break up today for half term. We return to school on Monday 3rd June. We hope you have a great week and fingers crossed the sun stays out!

Missing school...



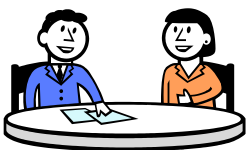
...is missing out!

Every day absent from school is an opportunity missed and we strongly advise that you do not take students out for holidays during term time.

UNACCEPTABLE REASONS FOR ABSENCE

- *Holidays taken due to cheaper prices.*
- *Non-urgent medical and dental appointments.*
- *Shopping.*
- *Birthday treats and trips.*

Requests for leave of absence must be put in writing on the leave of absence form available from the office. Mrs Finn may authorise leave of absence if your child's attendance is **97%** based on most relevant attendance records, but will look at each individual request which will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances.



If your request is denied by school and your child still has time off it will be marked as unauthorised. Once your child has 10 unauthorised sessions on their attendance record the Education

Welfare Officer will be involved, especially if your child already has low attendance

A two week holiday taken during term time is over 50 lessons missed. This means your child will fall behind with their work. Time missed can lead to gaps in knowledge that become difficult to fill.



Good school attendance includes arriving to school on time and being in school every day.
