## PARENTS FORUM

Thank you to those of you who came to the informal Parent Forum on Tuesday. I hope you found it useful and it was very helpful to hear your comments/views on the school's work and those areas that we are prioritising. Topics discussed included: Reading, Maths, uniform, school meals, website, homework and communication.



Can I please, please remind parents that, although the rule regarding the wearing of ties was relaxed during the hot weather our uniform policy remains the same. Children are expected to wear a shirt and tie, plus school shoes. This does include trainer style shoes but only if they are black. It is really important that our children have a sense of pride in belonging to Rosemellin School and we would very much appreciate your help in making sure our children are smart. We have been discussing uniform but there is, and has been, no change.

I have also been working closely with our cook in charge, Mrs Levick, who, alongside her team do such a good job of ensuring our children are fed. No mean feat as the school increases in number and lunch time is only an hour! We have been talking about the fact that for some of our children, a sandwich is becoming the everyday choice so, after half term, the menu is changing. We are removing sandwiches, wraps and baps and there will be a hot meal, a vegetarian option and jacket potatoes as a daily option. A salad bar will also be available for the children to select from. We may re-introduce sandwiches as an option during the Summer Term but will keep you posted.
