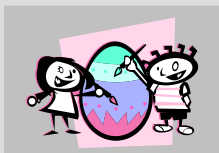
Rosemellin School Egg Rolling Competition



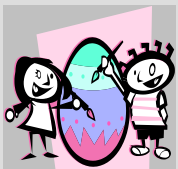
The international egg rolling competition will be held in school on Thursday 4th April 2019.

WELL DONE FINN!

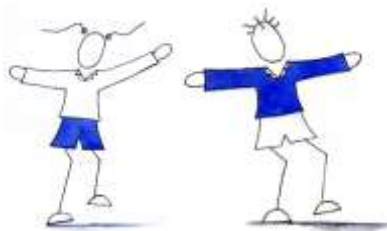
